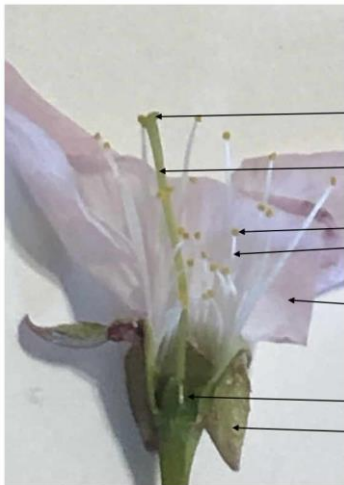


Crab Apple Suite

1. What different colours are the blossoms of crab trees?

White, light pink or dark pink



2. What do crab apples look like?

They look like small or mini apples

3. Can you eat crab apples?

Yes, but they are very tart or sour – best as pickled in a syrup.
The leaves are poisonous or toxic!

4. How big do crab apple trees grow?

They grow an average of 3 metres to 8 metres

5. What conditions have crab apples been used to heal?

Crab apples have been used to treat fever, indigestion, inflammation and constipation.
